

Covid Catch Up Funding Plan 2020-21

Following baseline assessments in September 2020 across Key Stage 1 and 2, the school identified that some children had fallen back in reading, writing and maths. The school is focusing on catch up in reading, writing and maths.

Writing is highlighted in the School Improvement Plan(SIP) and is an area where a large number of children need support to recover their stamina and remember the basic skills.

Some pupil premium funding has been used to target catch up in maths and reading in the Autumn 2020 and Spring Term 2021. The school plans to use the 'Catch Up' funding for Reading, Writing and Maths interventions addressing specific gaps identified through teacher assessment. The school will use Teacher or Teaching Assistant support to deliver intervention in small groups or one to one. Progress measures will be SMART. The school has skilled staff to provide the targeted support.
