Information for September 2021

Dear Parents / Carers,

I hope that you are all enjoying the Summer holiday and looking forward to the new term. I am writing to update you about the arrangements for September.

As you will be aware Government guidance has changed regarding arrangements for schools but it is important to make sure that everyone is as safe as possible. We do not have to keep the children in strict bubbles and whole classes will not have to isolate if there is a positive case. Masks on the playground are no longer required however they can still be worn through personal choice.

We will be able to return to some of the arrangements that were in place before restrictions.

Beginning of the day.

All children will be able to come into school from 8.45am and should be in the classrooms by 9.00am, when the register will be taken. Parents are welcome to bring the children into the playground and a member of staff from each class will be outside to meet you.

Springfield will use the main gate and the side entrance door.

Newlands will use the main gate and come into school through the main entrance

Hoad will use the middle gate and the main entrance

Birkrigg will use the bottom gate and the entrance into their outdoor area.

End of the Day

All children will finish school at 3.15pm.

Parents can wait in the playground and staff will bring the children out.

Please remember to leave promptly and use the same gate as previously. If you have children in more than one class, please enter and leave by the most convenient gate.

Children should continue to bring a water bottle to leave in school as the water fountains will not be used. These are for water only in the classrooms. Children can bring juice for lunchtimes if they wish.

We will carry on with the hand washing routines and there will be a hand sanitiser by each entrance into school for children and visitors to use.

Cleaning will take place throughout the day during every break and lunch time. The one way system will remain in the corridors.

Infants and Juniors will have separate playtimes and lunchtimes and the children will be able to eat their lunch in the hall instead of in the classrooms.

Visitors will be allowed in school if essential and they have an appointment.

As always, please do not send your child to school if they have any symptoms of Covid 19.

All arrangements will be kept under review and changed if necessary.

I look forward to seeing everyone on 2nd September.
