Some of the governors have been appointed by the Diocese, some are parents and others are appointed by the governing board. A Foundation Governor is appointed by the Diocese and one of their main roles is to help maintain the Christian character of the school.

In our school the governors are the employers and therefore they are accountable for the progress and decisions the school makes. The Governing body help to make the school run smoothly by aiding in the appointment of staff, advising on maintenance of the school building and ensuring it is safe, making sure the school and the finances are managed effectively, monitoring and evaluating the curriculum and keeping up to date with policies. All of which contribute to making Church Walk a fun and safe learning environment for everyone.

Terms of office last for four years. Governors have to register their business interests and none have been disclosed. This is a standing item at all committee meetings and full governing body meetings.

Governors are required to hold at least three meetings every year of the Full Governing Body and attend relevant committee meetings each term.
Finance and Personnel committee meet every month.

The Safeguarding, Sites and Buildings Committee meets termly. The Curriculum Committee meets as required.

Other committees include Admissions, Appeals, Staff Recruitment, Staff Discipline and Dismissal and Pupil Discipline. These are called whenever necessary.
