Hoad Summer 2 24 Parent Curriculum over view Year 1

Literacy

We are using the texts 'The Curious Case of the Missing Mammoth' and a selection of poems from Michael Rosen's 'A great Big Cuddle' as the basis for our creative writing this half term. We will also write for different purposes e.g. labels for our artwork and stories about Florence Nightingale in history.

Library Change day is Monday and home-school reading books are changed ready to come out on Tuesdays and Fridays. If you would like to keep books longer in order to help develop fluency or because texts are longer, please either pop a note in your child's reading record or keep the folder at home.

Our animal -themed Library Challenge books are proving popular and will continue to come home during this half term.

<u>Maths</u>

We will be investigating fractions, position and direction, money and numbers to 100.

White Rose Maths (the scheme we use throughout the school for teaching maths) has developed a '1 Minute Maths' app for parents and pupils that helps children practice the four main calculations, supporting the work we do in class using different maths visuals and manipulatives.

Children are learning to count in 2s,5s and 10s as preparation for learning the tables associated with these number sequences.

<u>Science</u>

We are going to look at different life cycles linked to both plants and animals; look at how plants have adapted to extremes of climate (desert and polar) and start to think about our senses. We will devise investigations into the importance of light in human sight and how our noses help us smell and detect different senses.

<u>History</u>

The theme for this half's term's work is the life of a significant person in British history. We will be looking at the life of Florence Nightingale and the impact of her life and experiences on modern nursing.

<u>RE</u>

This half term we are going to be looking at the Bible and why it is such a special book for Christians. We will think about our favourite Bible stories and which testament they are found in as well as learning about the Dead Sea scrolls and the sacred texts of other world faiths.

PSHCEE

We will be continuing our unit on keeping healthy looking at exercise, maintaining healthy teeth, sleep patterns and promoting good mental health. We will also think about how to keep safe in the summer by looking at caring for our skin in the sun and being safe around e.g. water or busy places.

<u>Art</u>

The focus for this half term's work is weaving. We will look at the art of different cultures including Ghanian kente weaving and the work of famous textile artists such as Gunta Stolzl before designing, completing and evaluating our own woven pieces using different mediums.

<u>PE</u>

After some athletics-based training as preparation for Sports Day we will extend our work on leaping and landing to incorporate low to medium apparatus and devise, then refine simple sequences using jumps and landings we have practised.

Computing

The children will explore different ways of presenting ideas. We will explore e-books, mind maps, quizzes and fact files before creating a non-fiction presentation on a chosen topic.

<u>Music</u>

This half term we will listen to and appraise classical music. We will look at different parts of compositions and learn more about pulse, rhythm, pitch, tempo and dynamics.
